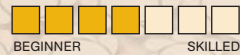


Create your own Greetings Card Topper

Easy Metal - versatile leaf metal

SKILLOMETER



WHAT YOU NEED:

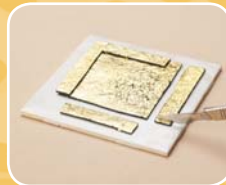
Easy Metal (assorted colours),
FIMO Soft – black,
FIMO Liquid Deko Gel,
Ceramic tile, Craft knife, Glue



1 Working on a ceramic tile, roll a sheet of softened black FIMO 2mm thick and cover with a sheet of Easy Metal, rubbing gently so that it adheres to the surface of the FIMO.



2 Cut a square to fit the dimensions of your card blank, plus four strips for the frame. Place the strips on top of the square, trimming the two shorter sides to fit. Press down firmly.



3 Cut several thin strips and press down inside the frame as stems. Cut another strip into short lengths and arrange in a circle at the top of each stem as petals, finishing with a single piece in the centre to make your flower.



4 Ensure all pieces are pressed firmly into place. To seal the Easy Metal, cover your topper completely with FIMO Liquid Deko Gel. Spills over the edges can be sliced off after you have baked your topper according to instructions and allowed to cool slightly. Once completely cool, arrange on your card blank, gluing into place.
