

Create your own Mosaic Mirror

WHAT YOU NEED:

- FIMO - assorted colours
- Ceramofix® powder
- Mirror
- Rolling pin
- Craft knife
- Cloth

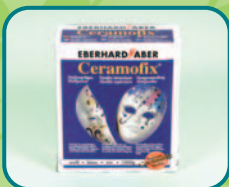

1 Roll out three sheets of FIMO in light green, dark green and light brown and cut into small, equally sized squares.



2 Cut a sheet of rolled white FIMO into a rectangle and using a knife, gently mark the outline of a lizard. Position four dark green squares together to form a diamond, and repeat pressing all along the back, and fill in the remainder of your lizard with light green squares. Finish with black circles for eyes and light green circles for toes. You can add a mirror at this stage by pressing into the FIMO base and filling in the surrounding area with light brown squares.



3 Once your FIMO mirror has been baked and allowed to cool according to instructions, mix some Ceramofix® powder into a paste with a little water.



4 Using a cloth, spread Ceramofix® across your mosaic ensuring all the gaps are filled. Using a clean, damp cloth, buff the surface removing any excess Ceramofix®. You can finish your mosaic with a coat of FIMO gloss varnish.
