

# Create your own Picture Frame

oven hardening modelling material

## WHAT YOU NEED:

- FIMO - assorted colours
- Ceramofix® powder
- Picture frame
- Rolling pin
- Craft knife
- Cloth

**8+** adult supervision required

## SKILLOMETER



**1** Roll out several lengths of light brown FIMO and wrap around a picture frame, blending the edges to make neat joins.



**2** Roll out three sheets of FIMO in light brown, dark brown and blue and cut into small, equally sized squares.



**3** Gently press the squares onto the FIMO covered picture frame creating any pattern you choose. Squares can be cut in half diagonally to make triangles. Don't forget to cover the sides of the frame as well as the front! Bake the whole covered frame according to instructions and allow to cool.



**4** Mix some Ceramofix® powder into a paste with a little water and using a cloth, spread Ceramofix® across your mosaic picture frame ensuring all the gaps are filled. Using a clean, damp cloth, buff the surface removing any excess Ceramofix®. You can finish your mosaic with a coat of FIMO gloss varnish.
